NOTES

- •This marks the 15th meeting with Jacksonville State
- Jacksonville State leads 12-2 the series
- The two TSU wins have occurred in Jacksonville, Ala. (2006 and 2013)
- Rod Reed is 1-8 versus the Gamecocks

Last Meeting

- Tennessee State jumped out to an early lead only to see Jacksonville State comeback to claim a OFF. COORD. SHANNON HARRIS (2ND) 31-23 victory.
- The Tigers scored two touchdowns and went for 313 yards in the first half to build a 20-17 halftime lead.
- •JSU's pass game proved to be the difference in the second half as they totaled 200 yards and two touchdowns.
- Senior running back Te'kendrick Roberson finished the night with 93 rushing yards on 15 carries.
- Chris Rowland added 226 all purpose yards, 78 rushing, 113 receiving and 35 on kick returns.
- Rhashaun Epting led the defense with a game high 13 tackles, five solo, and helped on a tackle for loss.
- Antonio Zita finished the night with 11 points, kicking three field goals and two extra points.
- Kaleb Mosley registered a 50-plus yard punt for the seventh consecutive game in-a-row.

Head Coach Rod Reed

- Coach Reed is in his 11th season at the helm of the Tigers and holds a 56-57 record.
- •Only two coaches have produced more wins at TSU.
- John Merritt claimed 174 victories in his 20 years (1963-83) for a .806 winning percentage (174-35-7), while Harry Kean spent 10 years in charge of TSU from 1944-54 and compiled a 93-15-3 record (.838).
- TSU is 9-2 in season openers under Rod Reed, including a 17-10 win at FBS opponent Georgia State in 2017.
- The loss to Austin Peay was the first opening day defeat since a 12-9 decision to Bethune-Cookman in 2013.

Tennessee State

- The Tigers are coming off the wrong end of a 27-20 decision at Austin Peay.
- The loss dropped TSU to 0-1 in the Ohio Valley Conference and 0-1 in the chase for the Sqt. York Trophy.
- •The Big Blue found themselves behind the Govs 20-0 just eight minutes into the contest.
- For the remainder of the game, the Tigers outgained APSU 332-182 and outscored the home team 20-7.
- Deveon Bryant earned the start at quarterback and played deep into the third quarter, throwing for 61 yards and a touchdown, while rushing for 16 yards on five carries.
- •Isaiah Green entered in the fourth quarter and brought the Tigers back, completing 10-of 18 passes for 173 yards and one touchdown.
- Vincent Perry and Cam Wyche each caught touchdown passes.
- Perry pulled in four passes for 60 yards to go along with Wyche's three receptions for 75 yards.
- Devon Starling came off the bench to lead the Big Blue in rushng, gaining 55 yards on 15 attempts.
- Dayron Johnson totaled 242 all-purpose yards, including 140 yards on returns.
- Antonio Zita finished 2-of-3 on field goal attempts and 2-of-2 on extra points for eight points.
- Defensively, Nyle Love led the squad with 12 tackles, six solo.
- Justin Brown and Davoan Hawkins added seven stops each.
- Brown made three stops behind the line of scrimmage, including 1.5 sacks.
- •Love, Hawkins and Nate Sutton all picked up half a sack.
- Kendall Johnson was credited with a blocked punt.

Fresh Starts

- Six Tigers on offense gained their first start at Austin Peay.
- Deveon Bryant, Cam Wych, Vincent Perry, Sean McMoore and Robert Lacey all gained starts in their first action for the Tigers.
- · Shawn McColley earned his first start for the Big Blue after playing in nine contests in each of the last two seasons.
- Transfers Curt McDonald, Davoan Hawkins and Tadarrius Patterson each gained their first start at Austin Peay.
- In all, 25 players saw the field for the first time in blue.

- The Tigers recorded 12 Tackles for Loss and three sacks in week
- The top game in 2019 for TFLs came against Eastern Illinois
- The last time the Tigers amassed at least 12 stops behind the line of scrimmage came on Nov. 4, 2017 versus Virginia Lynchburg.
- The last time TSU finished with 12 or more TFLs against an NCAA D-I came on Nov. 7, 2015 against Murray State.
- A season ago, the defense collected two sacks in each of the
- The three sacks against APSU was the most in game for the Tigers since a four sack outing versus Tennessee Tech on Oct. 20, 2018.
- In 2019, Chris Rowland finished his senior campaign with
- Rowland's 175.83 all-purpose yards per game led the OVC and
- In his first game as the primary return specialist, Dayron John-
- The sophomore's 242.0 all-purpose yards per game ranks first
- Johnson returned three kickoffs for 96 yards and three punts
- The wide receiver also pulled down four passes for 95 yards
- Johnson leads the OVC and ranks third in FCS in both kickoff return average (32.0) and punt return average (14.7).

- In the season opener, Austin Peay gained 186 yards on its first four plays and scored three touchdowns.
- The Govs averaged 46.5 yards per play and 62.0 yards per rush over the first eight minutes of the game.
- Over the final three and a half quarters the Big Blue held APSU to 182 yards on 55 plays for an average of 3.3 yards per play.
- Rushing wise, Austin Peay rushed 38 times for 64 yards the rest of the way, averaging 1.7 yards per carry.
- An even deeper look shows the Tigers holding the Govs to 22 yards on the ground on 31 rushes for the final three quarters, an average of 0.7 yards per run.

Location Breakdown

- The 2021 Tigers are represented by 11 states.
- Of the 91 players on the squad, 33 hail from Tennessee, while 19 come from Florida and 18 from Georgia.
- · Alabama is represented by eight players, while four are from Illinois and two each from Mississippi, Texas and Pennsylvania.
- Hawaii and Virginia each have one athlete.

Long Time Coming

- The game versus Austin Peay was the first game for Tennessee State in 463 days.
- The Tigers had last played on Nov. 23, 2019, in Cookeville, Tenn., before the game on Feb. 28, 2021 in Clarksville, Tenn.
- During that time, the Govs played seven games.
- TSU earned a 37-27 win at Tennessee Tech during the final game of the 2019 season..
- •The Ohio Valley Conference postponed all fall sports on Aug. 14 due to concerns and the uncertainty surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The Tigers were scheduled to play on Sunday, Feb. 21 against Jacksonville State but a winter storm through the middle Tennessee area forced postponement delaying the 2021 spring season.

Sustaining the Drive

- In the first season under offensive coordinator Shannon Harris the Tigers embarked on 50 scoring drives in 2019.
- Just under half of those drives went for 70 yards or more.
- TSU produced four scoring drives in the 2021 spring opener against Austin Peay.
- All four drives were between 50-59 yards (53-FG, 56-TD, 59-FG, 59-TD).
- In 2019, The Big Blue made the long drives count as 16 of the 22 from 70-plus went for touchdowns.
- The highest amount of scoring drives (16) ranged between 70-79 yards.
- Four went for 80-89 yards while two traveled 90-99.
- Another 13 of the 50 drives were over 50 yards (four from 50-59, nine from 60-69).
- The offense had 35 of the 50 drives cover half the field.

Condensed Schedule

- Due to the pandemic the 2020 season was reduced to a conference only spring season.
- The schedule consists of a seven game round robin facing each team in the OVC with the exception of Eastern Kentucky.
- The Colonels opted out after playing nine games in the fall.
- In 2018, the Tigers played just nine games due to two cancellations due to weather.
- \bullet The Southern Heritage Classic versus Jackson State was cancelled due to lightning.
- The following week, the Tigers game at Hampton was cancelled due to Hurricane Florence.
- The seven game slate is the smallest for TSU since 1957.
- The Big Blue under the direction of Howard Gentry finished the '57 campaign at 5-0-1.

Having A Voice

- Junior Raymond Horton was selected to serve on the NCAA Division
 Football Oversight Committee Student-Athlete Connection Group.
- The defensive lineman is one of two student-athletes from the Ohio Valley Conference.
- •The group's goal is to gather broad-based feedback from D-I football student-athletes on multiple issues. The topics include COVID-19 health and safety measures, transfer issues, name, image and likeness topics and social justice issues.
- The committee will meet quarterly to discuss issues and provide feedback.
- Horton is joined by Tennessee Tech's Seth Carlisle and Eastern Illinois head coach Adam Cushing, who is the FCS level head coach representative.

TSU vs. HBCUs

- The 2021 spring season will be the first time Tennessee State has not faced a Historically Black College and University (HBCU).
- Tennessee State University holds a 399-143-19 record against other HBCUs, good for a .728 winning percentage.
- The Tigers finished 1-2 versus HBCUs in 2019.
- Since taking over in 2010, Rod Reed holds a 22-6 against HB-CUs for a winning percentage of .786.
- TSU's most wins against D-I HBCU opponents are: Florida A&M (29), Jackson State (28) and Southern (27).

- Antonio Zita returns for his third season with the Tigers after deciding to transfer to NCAA D-II West Florida.
- Zita comes back after one semester away from Tennessee State.
 The junior regained his honor as a Preseason All-OVC selection.
- As a sophomore, the kicker set a single season program record with 20 field goals.
- The mark also tied for fifth best in OVC history.
- Zita finished 2019 with a .833 field goal percentage (20-for-24), which led the OVC and ranked sixth in the FCS.
- Zita earned an honorable mention spot on the HERO Sports Sophomore All-America team.

Pushing 50

- Kaleb Mosley was named to the Preseason All-OVC team after leading the conference in 2019 averaging 42.2 yards per punt.
- Mosley was named as one of 22 candidates on the Augusta Sports Council preseason FCS Punter of the Year Award watch list.
- The list is based on the 2019 watch list, 2019 honors and 2020 preseason recognition.
- Mosley recorded punts of 50-plus yards in seven consecutive games dating back to the final game of the 2018 season through the first six games of 2019.
- The junior booted a 57 yard punt at Jacksonville State in the final game of the streak, before missing the next two games due to surgery.
- After his return, Mosley closed the season with a punt of 45 or more yards over the final four games, including a 58-yard boot at UT Martin.
- The punt was the third longest of his career, behind a 64-yarder against Mississippi Valley State (8-31-19) and a 61-yarder at Eastern Kentucky (9-28-19).
- The 64 yard punt is the eighth longest in program history.

- Adams ranks second at Tennessee State in career passing yards with 8,653.
- The Gulfport, Miss., native tossed a TSU single season best 30 touchdowns in 1980 and 75 in his career (1977-80).
- Adams was drafted by the San Francisco 49ers in the 12th round of the 1981 NFL Draft.
- He continued his professional career by playing three seasons in the Canadian Football League with the Saskatchewan Roughriders, Toronto Argonauts and Ottawa Rough Riders.
- Six TSU greats have been previously inducted. Eldridge Dickey and Claude Humphrey entered in 2012, Joe Gilliam, Jr., Ed Too Tall' Jones and John Merritt were enshrined in 2013 and Richard Dent was the latest entrant in 2015.
- Robert Porcher, spent two seasons at TSU, redshirting in 1987 before playing for the Big Blue in 1988, was a 2017 inductee.

Many New Faces

- TSU sports 43 new members on the team in 2021.
- \bullet Of the 70 Tigers suiting up at Austin Peay, 36 will be in uniform for the first time.
- Some key new additions on offense are quarterback David Johnson, running backs Devon Starling and Jalen Rouse, as well as wide receivers Cam Wyche, Vincent Perry, Cedric Watkins and Zaire Thornton.
- Transfer's Sean McMoore (Vanderbilt) and Robert Lacey (Hutchinson CC) are ticketed as starters on the front line.
- On defense, Tadarrius Patterson, Nate Sutton, Emmanuel Baez, Detoye Adewole, Chris Walker and Davoan Hawkins look to make an impact in the front seven, along with linebackers Kendall Johnson and Ahmad Nelson.
- Freshman Kenyon Andrews looks to provide depth in the backfield.

- Levine sat out week six of the season due to injury snapping a streak of consecutive games played at 117.
- The streak which began in 2013 was the third longest active run for the Ravens behind punter Sam Koch and kicker Justin Tuck.
- Levine is fifth on the Ravens all-time streak behind Koch, Turner, Jarret Johnson (129) and Joe Flacco (122).
- -Terrell Bonds played in four games for the Ravens before his season was cut short by an injury in week against the New England Patriots.
- The cornerback made six tackles and appeared in 84 defensive snaps.
- Bonds registered his first NFL tackle against the Pittsburgh Steelers and earned his first start versus the Indianapolis Colts.
- Bonds signed a reserve/futures contract with the Miami Dolphins which will take effect in March.
- Chris Rowland spent most of the season as a protected practice squad player and was activated for the final two games of the season where he served as a return specialist.

- The offensive lineman was inactive for the final seven games of the season.

ROD REED HEAD COACH 11th Season

OVERALL RECORD: 56-57 **OVC RECORD: 29-46**

Rod Reed enters his eighth season at the helm of the Tennessee State football program after being named head coach on December 18, 2009. He served as the associate head coach and defensive coordinator during the 2009 season.

Reed experienced immediate success as a head coach, leading the Tigers to a win in his debut game, 27-14, over Alabama A&M on Sept. 4, 2010 in the John Merritt Classic. He also broke an eight-game losing streak to Florida A&M, downing the Rattlers, 29-18, in the Atlanta Classic. Reed coached six players to All-OVC Teams including safety Eugene Clifford who also was a Sports Network, Phil Steele and BOXTOROW All-American.

The Tigers increased their win total in their second season under Reed and finished the 2011 season on a hot streak. winning four of their last six games. The stretch included a, 42-40, upset win at No. 19 ranked Tennessee Tech on Oct. 15. Reed produced even more All-OVC players in year two, as seven made postseason squads. Two more defenders garnered All-American honors under Reed's tutelage in linebacker Rico Council and Joseph Wylie. He also helped Lamar Divens and Sidney Tarver ink NFL contracts.

The Big Blue continued its success in 2012 by rattling off seven straight victories to open the season. The Tigers finished the year with an 8-3 record, its best since 2001. The performance earned TSU HBCU Program of the Year honors by HBCU Huddle. Several players earned postseason accolades including running back Trabis Ward who was named to the College Sports All-American Team after running for 1,460 yards and 15 touchdowns. Three more Tigers were Sheridan All-Americans including Sherman Carter who signed an NFL deal with fellow offensive lineman Rogers Gaines following suit.

Reed turned in his finest season to date in 2013, as the Tigers finished 10-4 and won a FCS Playoff Game for the first time since 1986. It capped an impressive run in which Reed improved his club's win total by at least two in each of his first four campaigns. TSU won its first HBCU National Championship since 1982 and the team's shutout win over Butler in the first round of the playoffs was the first victory for the OVC in postseason play in nearly 30 years. A school record 12 Tigers were chosen to the league's all-conference teams at season's end and Kadeem Edwards (143rd) and Demetrius Rhaney (250th) were selected in the NFL Draft.

In 2014, Reed's defense ranked inside the top-10 for the third

straight season. Middle linebacker Nick Thrasher tallied 128 stops on the season, which was sixth-most in a single-season in school history and the highest total for a Tiger since 1991. Thrasher also moved up to second-place in tackles in the TSU record book over the course of the season, finishing with 358. Quarterback Mike German threw for 2,846 yards on the year, helping him break the 34 year old school-mark with 8,664 career yards.

After breaking a streak of three consecutive non-losing seasons in 2015, the Tigers bounced back to finish 7-4 in 2016. TSU reemerged as one of the top teams in the OVC under Reed with nine all-conference players and six All-Americans. The offense led the OVC in points scored and finished second in total offense. Cornerback Ezra Robinson and offensive lineman Jessamen Dunker both earned First Team All-OVC selections, All-American status and were invited to play in the Reese's Senior Bowl. The duo also participated in the NFL combine and signed free agent

Reed has coached a total of 28 All-Americans and 62 All-OVC Players in his seven seasons as a head coach and has staked a 43-37 record.

He began coaching at TSU in 2003 and served as the defensive coordinator and linebackers coach. At the conclusion of the season in which Reed returned to the TSU sideline, the Tigers led the OVC in total defense for the first time in school history. The defense accomplished the same feat in 2008 finishing at the top of the OVC in total defense.

A keen recruiter as an assistant, Reed was responsible for bringing several notable key players into the TSU program. Reed is noted for recruiting Javarris Williams (2009 seven-round draft pick, Kansas City Chiefs), Dominique Rodgers-Cromartie (2008 first-round draft pick, Arizona Cardinals), Shaun Richardson, Lamar Divens (Baltimore Ravens, 2008) and Cornelius Lewis. He has also coached All-America and professional player, Jamar Landrom (Jacksonville Jaguars).

Reed was a four-year letter winner for the TSU Tigers from 1984 - 1988. He capped off his career by being named Sheridan All-America his senior season. He set the Tiger record for career tackles from his linebacker slot and in 1987, he set the single season record for tackles with 197. He helped lead the Tigers to the second round of the 1986 Division I-AA playoffs and was selected as Defensive MVP in 1987 and 1988.

Following completion of his bachelor's degree, Reed entered the coaching profession. He held positions at Prairie View A&M (Linebackers, 2001), Bethune-Cookman University (Linebackers, 92-95), and Seabreeze High School (DC, 96-00) in Daytona Beach, Fla. Within those positions he coached five first-team all-conference linebackers and a pair of All-Americans.

Before coming to TSU, Reed previously coached at East Texas

Baptist College (00-03) in his hometown of Marshall, Texas. He served as defensive coordinator for East Texas Baptist, which launched its football program during the 2000 season.

The 2002 Texas Baptist defense ranked second in their conference in scoring defense and third in rushing defense. The team did not allow points in either the first or third periods through the first eight games in 2002.

Reed is the son of Robert Reed, Jr., an All-America offensive guard for the Tigers in 1963 and 1964 who later played professionally for the Washington Redskins.

Reed is the university's Fellowship of Christian Athletes representative and in 2009 he participated in the NCAA Football Coaches Academy. He and his wife, Tamika, are the parents of our children, Terry, Takara, Briah, and Marcel.



In July 2007, the Nashville Sports Council and the Ohio Valley Conference announced the creation of the Sergeant York Trophy which goes to the winner of the quadrangular season football series between the four Ohio Valley Conference schools located in the state of Tennessee – Austin Peay State University, University of Tennessee at Martin, Tennessee State University and Tennessee Technological University.

The award is only the second traveling trophy that involves more than two teams in college sports; the other is the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972.

In a close race, Tennessee State and Austin Peay shared the inaugural award, finishing with identical 2-1 records in 2007. Tennessee State took the trophy home thanks to a one-point victory in overtime over the Governors; that game was decided by a block extra point by NFL First Round Draft Pick Dominique Rodgers-Cromartie. The Tigers repeated as champions in 2008, winning all three of its Sgt. York games.

The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. As a corporal in the 2nd battalion, 328th Infantry, in the Battle of the Meuse River-Argonne (Oct. 8, 1918), York and seven other soldiers captured 132 prisoners, was promoted to sergeant and received the Distinguished Service Cross, the French Croix de Guerre, the French Legion of Honor, the Croce di Guerra of Italy and the War Medal of Montenegro. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of

Following the war, York returned his home in Pall Mall, Tenn. (located in north central Tennessee, 55 miles

northeast of Cookeville) where he dedicated his life to improving education and facilitating educational opportunities for children in the state of Tennessee. In 1927, he established the Alvin C. York Institute after spending several years raising money for the school which opened as a private institution. That school was established, in part, to provide educational opportunities denied to the boys and girls of Fentress Country. In 1937, the Institute became a state special school after an appeal to the Tennessee State Legislature. The school, located in Jamestown, Tenn., is still in operation today.

York died on Sept. 2, 1964 and the foundation which he helped establish in 1920 — The Sergeant York Patriotic Foundation — was dormant for many years. The Foundation was re-established by Lipscomb Davis, Jr. in 1992 and is currently run by Sgt. York's grandson Gerald (U.S. Army Colonel, Retired). York's papers are archived by Michael E. Birdwell, Ph.D., who is an associate professor of history at Tennessee Technological University, one of the four institutions that will compete for the yearly honor.

After the completion of the football season, the Sergeant York Trophy is awarded to the institution withthe best head-to-head record in the match-ups with their fellow Tennessee schools. In the event of a tie, the award is shared; however, the previous winner will retain the trophy if they are part of the tie. If the tie is between two other institutions, the trophy will go to the institution that has gone the most seasons without winning the trophy.

The award is presented to the winning institution annually at the Pepsi Celebration of Champions which is hosted each spring by the Nashville Sports Council. The event was created in 1999 and salutes amateur and professional sports in Tennessee.
