AT A GLANCE ▶ ▶

▶ The Tennessee State University men's basketball team hosts undefeated Chattanooga at home, Tuesday, Dec. 22 with 2 p.m. tip on ESPN+ and Big Blue Sports Network.

- ▶This will be the third game the Tigers play in just five days all at home in the Gentry Center. Game one versus OVC rival Belmont occured on Friday, Dec. 18. The team had a quick 25 hour turnaround to play Crowley's Ridge Saturday, Dec. 19. Big Blue has had just a 48 hour break before taking on another powerhouse in UTC.
- ▶ After garnering a 1-1 record in 25 hours with a 88-63 loss to Belmont and a 90-68 win over Crowley's Ridge, the Tigers are 1-3 and ranked 11th in the OVC.

OVC LEADERS

- ▶ TSU is ranked third in the OVC in offensive rebounds (11.8 pg) and second in steals (8.3 spg).
- Mark Freeman is fifth in the league in scoring, averaging 17 ppg, second in free throw percentage (.895 (17-of-19)), fourth in steals (2.3)
- ▶ Josh Linder averages 61.9 percent from the floor ranking fifth (13-of-21).
- ▶ Averaging 3.5 offensive rebounds per game, Shakem Johnson ranks second in the league, 32nd in the nation.

TENNESSEE STATE NEWS AND NOTES ▶ ▶

LAST TIME OUT

Big Blue earned its first victory of the season Saturday evening at home over Crowley's Ridge College, 90-68.

▶Four Tigers notched double-digit scoring on the way

▶ Four Tigers notched double-digit scoring on the way to a 90-point win, including center Josh Linder, who finished with 10 points, six rebounds. Alongside the Georgia State transfer was Nashville-native Marcus Fitzgerald, Jr. who led the team with 17 points, registering a career-high in his home city.

► Monty Johal 12, Marcus Fitzgerald Jr.17 and Josh Linder 10 registered career highs.

LAST TIME OUT AGAINST THE MOCS

- After a 16-year hiatus, the Tigers and the Mocs met last season, two hours southeast of Nashville in Chattanooga.
- ► The Tigers created a 29-25 lead in the first half that the Mocs soon battled back from.
- ▶ In the final seconds of the night, Marshall was fouled while pulling up for a three-point bucket with one second left in the game. A miss and a three-point deficit led to a TSU timeout to craft a game plan.
- ▶ Marshall. At the line. First free throw swish. Second free throw bounced off the backboard in hopes of a Big Blue rebound and a layup to tie. The rebound was grabbed by Chatt and the game buzzer sounded, 59-57. ▶ The Tigers suffered its first loss of the season while the Mocs added its first win.

UNPRECEDENTED START

- ▶ In a normal season, the Tigers would take on a slate of nonconference opponents before entering OVC play. This season Big Blue's first opponents out of the gate were the league's reigning champs, Belmont.
- In fact, TSU played the crosstown rival twice in 10 days, marking two of the first three games for the Tigers.
- ▶ Big Blue's season, like many across the country, had been delayed from its original Nov. 26 start date due to COVID protocols causing the team to miss two games against Coppin State and Marshall in Huntington, WV.

FROM THE SIX(TH)

► Tennessee State was picked to finish sixth by the Preseason Media Poll and conference poll of the head coaches and SIDs. ► Shakwon Barrett, junior guard, hails from Toronto, Ontario, serving as our first international player on the squad since

Kamar McKnight in 2018, who was also from Toronto.

HBCU FAMILY

- ▶ Freshman Evan Joyner's father is Jay Joyner the 2018 MEAC Coach of the Year. Joyner coached the Aggies of NC A&T where he helped the team to its first 20-win season in 31 years.
- ▶ Senior Advisor to the Head Coach Cy Alexander served as the head coach at South Carolina State where he coaches the Bulldogs to a 276-200 record over a decade and a half. He then took the helm of the TSU Tigers from

2003-2009 before heading to NCA&T from 2012-2016.

MAY I ASSIST?

▶ Mark Freeman averaged 4.2 assists as a freshman for the Tigers. Returning as the full-time starting point guard, the Memphis native has continued to lead the floor, averaging a team-high 3.0 apg.

Junior college transfer Shakwon Barrett led the team in assists in game one with four and continues to assist averaging 2.5 apg.

UNITY PLEDGE

The three divisional Student-Athlete Advisory Committees and the Board of Governors Student-Athlete Engagement Committee collaborated to create a unity pledge and logo that is represented on Big Blue's increase.

▶ The logo includes three different colored hands holding one another's wrists inside a circle with "United As One" at the bottom. The pledge debuted in a video Oct. 23 on the social media pages of the national SAACs.

"DESERVE TO WIN"

- TSU Head Coach Brian "Penny" Collins has dubbed "Deserve to Win" his phrase for the team.
- It is a philosophy that encompasses every aspect of the program from work in the weightroom to how the coaches and student-athletes interact with the community.
- ▶ The roster contains "well-rounded, high-character individuals, with high basketball IQs who lead by example on and off the court."

WHY PENNY?

b Head Coach Brian "Penny" Collins got his name as a kid. Collins, born in Memphis, moved to Nashville as a young pre-teen. In honor of his favorite college and NBA player, Penny Hardaway who played in his hometown, Collins would sport the Magic jersey while on the court. The name stuck.


▶ Collins claims both Memphis and Nashville as his hometown, as he was born in one, and raised in the other.




