### TIPOFF TIDBITS

Ray Harper owns 94 wins in five seasons at JSU, ranking second in program history for D1 wins behind former head coach Mike LaPlante (95 wins, eight seasons).

Jacksonville State leads the Ohio Valley Conference in defensive rebounds per game (27.9), field-goal percentage defense (40.8), total rebound (858) and rebounds per game (39.0).

Point guard Jalen Finch ranks 23rd in the nation for total assists with 106. The last Gamecocks to have 100+ assists in a single season were Malcolm Drumwright (130) and Jamal Gregory (106) in 2017-18.

Despite faltering in the late minutes, Jacksonville State's defense held Belmont to 0-for-16 from beyond the arc in the first half and to a season-low 11.5% from 3-point range for the game (3-for-26).

Jacksonville State's 14 wins rank third in the state of Alabama behind just UAB (16) and No. 8/9 Alabama (17).

### ADAMS SCORES PERSONAL-BEST 24

Darian Adams scored a new career-high Feb. 18 with 24 points at Belmont. The Montgomery, Ala., native was 9-for-15 from the field and hit four 3-pointers. Only two points came from the free-throw line on 2-for-2 shooting.

### DEFENSE TOUGH VS. BELMONT 3-POINTER

Despite faltering in the late minutes, Jacksonville State's defense held Belmont to 0-for-16 from beyond the arc in the first half and to a season-low 11.5% from 3-point range for the game (3-for-26) on Feb. 18 in Nashville.

### GAMECOCKS STRUGGLE IN LATE MINUTES

Jacksonville State is 3-5 this season in games decided by five points or less and have lost four games when leading with five minutes to play. The Gamecocks' Feb. 2 overtime loss to Eastern Kentucky was their second OT loss of the season. Both overtime games were against ECU.

### HUFFMAN HITS GAME-WINNING SHOT AGAINST TENNESSEE STATE

Brandon Huffman's dominance continued into JSU's Jan. 14 contest with Tennessee State. The 6-foot-10 senior hit the game-winning basket with five seconds left to lift Jax State to a 65-64 win over the Tigers. He finished with 17 points.

### THIRD-MOST WINS IN THE STATE

Jacksonville State's 14 wins rank third in the state of Alabama behind just UAB (16) and No. 8/9 Alabama (17).

### FOUR ROAD WINS IN A ROW

With wins at Murray State, Austin Peay, UT Martin and SEMO, Jacksonville State has won its last four road games in a row. The last time JSU put together a four-game winning streak on the road was the final four road games of 2018-19.

### SAME FIVE SCORE IN DOUBLE FIGURES FOR SECOND TIME

For the second time this season, Amanze Ngumezi (16), Brandon Huffman (13), Darian Adams (10), Demaree King (11) and Jalen Finch (11) each scored in double digits Feb. 13 against SIUE. The same five accomplished the feat for the first time Jan. 21 at Murray State.

### JSU'S DOMINANCE OVER SIUE

Jacksonville State has dominated SIUE since the Cougars joined the OVC. The Gamecocks' Feb. 13 win improved their record to 9-3 over SIUE, was their fifth win in a row over the Cougars and pushed their home record to an undefeated 5-0.

### HENRY MAKES #SCTOPIO

Kayne Henry's swat of a would-be shot by Eastern Illinois' Kashawn Charles was the No. 8 play of SportsCenter's Top 10 on Feb. 11. He is the first Gamecock to make the countdown since Jamal Gregory in 2018-19.

### LARGEST MARGIN OF VICTORY IS VS. SIUE

Jacksonville State's 90-54 defeat of SIUE on Jan. 12, 2019 is its largest margin of victory against a conference opponent in the program's Division I history. The 36-point victory is also the second-largest win in program history against a Division I opponent and second-largest win over a Division I program inside Pete Mathews Coliseum.

### HARPER AMONG DI JSU COACHES

In his fifth season at JSU, Ray Harper is on pace to become Jacksonville State's winningest Division I head coach. The 22-year veteran owns 94 wins at JSU, reaching the mark in just 157 games.

### FINCH WITH THE ASSIST

Jalen Finch ranks third in the OVC and 23rd in the NCAA with 106 total assists. His 4.8 assists per game are good for third in the conference and 59th in the nation.

### ADAMS DANGEROUS FROM 3-POINT RANGE

Darian Adams is one of the most dangerous 3-point shooters in the nation. The senior ranks 73rd in the NCAA and fourth in the OVC with 48 3-pointers made and 62nd in the nation and fourth in the league with 131 3-point attempts.

### DEFENSE HOLDS EIU IN CHECK

In their Feb. 11 win over EIU, the Gamecocks held the Panthers to a season-low 31.2 shooting percentage (24-for-77) and 19 points in the first half - the lowest-scoring half by an opponent.

### FIFTH WIN IN A ROW OVER UT MARTIN

Jax State's 82-70 win at UT Martin on Feb. 2 was the Gamecocks' fifth in a row over the Skyhawks. It was the 70th overall meeting between the two programs, and JSU pushed its advantage over UTM to 46-24 with the victory.

### OVERTIME GAMES VS. EASTERN KENTUCKY

Three of the last four overtime games played are against Eastern Kentucky. Two seasons ago, Jax State was on the winning side of a two-overtime contest at Pete Mathews Coliseum. Harper led JSU to a 104-101 victory that Feb. 23, 2019 night. Fastforward to Jan. 7, 2021, the Colonels claimed a 69-66 overtime contest in Richmond, Kentucky. JSU dropped its Feb. 2 OT game 86-82.

### HENRY, FINCH HIT NEW SCORING HIGHS

Senior Kayne Henry and junior Jalen Finch each scored new career highs Feb. 2 against Eastern Kentucky. Henry was 8-for-11 for 22 points, while Finch was 8-for-16 with 19 scored.

### HUFFMAN SWEEPS WEEKLY HONORS

After totaling 36 points, 12 rebounds and eight dunks at Murray State and Austin Peay, Brandon Huffman was voted the OVC Player of the Week, OVC Newcomer of the Week and College Sports Madness' OVC Player of the Week on Jan. 25. He is the first Gamecock to win multiple OVC honors in the same week since Trenton Marshall was named the league's Player of the Week and Newcomer of the Week on Jan. 11, 2010.

  - First win at the Dunn Center since Jan. 23, 2014.
  - APSU is first team to shoot better than 50 percent (52.9) against the JSU defense.

## SWEEPING APSU, MURRAY STATE ROAD SERIES FOR FIRST TIME

The Gamecocks took both games of the Austin Peay and Murray State road series for the first time in program history with wins Jan. 21 and 23. JSU has only won back-to-back games with Murray State and Austin Peay only one other time, winning the home series in 2012-13.

## ELEVEN DUNKS VS. GOVERNORS

JSU dunked a season-most 11 times at Austin Peay on Jan. 23. The previous high was seven. Brandon Huffman dunked seven times, while Juwan Perdue dunked twice, and Kayne Henry and Amanze Ngumezi each had one slam.

## HARPER'S 90TH WIN AT JAX STATE

Ray Harper earned his 90th win as JSU's coach Jan. 23 at Austin Peay. Harper is the fastest JSU coach to reach 90 Division I wins, and now ranks second among Jax State coaches for most DI wins in program history. His 90 wins are also his most victories at a DI program. He won 89 games in four-plus seasons at WKU from 2011 to 2016.

## FIRST ROAD WIN AT MURRAY STATE

JSU earned the program's first road win at Murray State on Jan. 21 at the CSFB Center. Jax State is 1-11 against the Racers on the road since the series began in 2003-04.

## FINCH EARNS FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Point guard Jalen Finch collected his first double-double Saturday, Jan. 21 at Murray State, totaling 15 points and 10 rebounds. He is the fifth Gamecock to score a double-double this season.

## ADAMS' 10-ASSIST CONTEST

Along with nearly scoring just the second triple-double in JSU history, Darian Adams became the first Gamecock to dish out 10 assists in a single game in four years. The last Gamecock to accomplish the feat was Malcolm Drumwright on Jan. 10, 2017 against Fort Valley State.

## NGUMEZI, ROUB SCORE IN THE 20'S

Martin Roub and Amanze Ngumezi showed JSU post players are dangerous shooters Jan. 16 against Belmont. Roub tied his single-game mark of 21 points, shooting 8-for-11 with five 3-pointers, while Ngumezi tied his single-game record of 20 points on 8-for-11 shooting with four treys. Both shot .727.

Darian Adams was a combined 0-for-16 from beyond the arc at ECU and Morehead State. The senior snapped the bucketless streak with a pair of late 3-pointers that kept the Gamecocks within one possession of the Tennessee State lead Jan. 14. Along with providing the game-winning assist to Brandon Huffman, the graduate transfer tied his career-high with 21 points.

### JAY PAL HAS BEST GAME AS A GAMECOCK

Head coach Ray Harper said sophomore Jay Pal had his best game in a JSU uniform Thursday, Jan. 14 against Tennessee State. The 6-foot-9 forward scored a career-high 10 points, grabbed seven rebounds and dished out seven assists.

### DARIAN ADAMS NAMED OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Senior guard Darian Adams was voted the OVC's Newcomer of the Week on Jan. 18 after scoring 39 points with 17 rebounds and 13 assists against Tennessee State and Belmont. He tallied 21 points and dished out the game-winning assist Thursday, Jan. 14 against TSU before nearly completing a triple-double against Belmont. The Troy transfer finished with 18 points, 10 assists and nine rebounds against the Bruins.

### BRANDON HUFFMAN NAMED JAN. 11 OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Senior Brandon Huffman was named the Ohio Valley Conference Newcomer of the Week on Jan. 11, as voted on by the league's sports information directors. The forward tallied 29 points, 26 rebounds and five blocks in contests at Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State. He is the second Gamecock this season to receive the weekly award, preceded by Amanze Ngumezi.

### HUFFMAN EARNS FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLES

Brandon Huffman's OVC Newcomer of the Week award comes on the shoulders of a pair of double-doubles. The 6-foot-10 center earned the team's first double-double - the first of his career - with 16 points and 16 rebounds Jan. 7 at Eastern Kentucky. He snagged his second double-double the following game with 13 points and 10 rebounds at Morehead State on Jan. 9.

### PERDUE GETS HIS FIRST DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Juwan Perdue recorded the first double-double of his career with 14 points and 10 rebounds Jan. 7 at ECU. He was just the second Gamecock of the season to score a double-double. Both set new single-game highs for the sophomore.

### HUFFMAN LABELED "MANCHILD" AT ECU

Senior Brandon Huffman was described as a "manchild" by Ray Harper and the ECU broadcasters following the Jan. 7 matchup with the Colonels. The forward had a career-high 16 points and 16 rebounds en route to the first double-double of his career. Huffman finished 7-for-16 from the floor and 2-for-5 from the charity stripe with four blocks.

### NGUMEZI HAS CAREER NIGHT VS. UTM

Junior Amanze Ngumezi could not be stopped Wednesday, Dec. 30. The forward scored a career-high 20 points and pulled down a single-game best eight rebounds in the 80-70 win over UT Martin at Pete Mathews Coliseum. He was just two boards shy of recording JSU's first double-double of the season.

### NGUMEZI IS OVC NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK

Following his 20-point, eight-rebound performance against UT Martin last Wednesday, Amanze Ngumezi was named the OVC's Newcomer of the Week, as voted on by the conference sports information directors. He is the first Gamecock to receive a weekly award from the league this season.

### NET RANKINGS RELEASED, JSU SECOND IN OVC WITH HIGHEST DEBUT

The NCAA released its first NET rankings of the season on Jan. 4, and Jacksonville State debuted at No. 140 - second in the OVC behind just Belmont (100). It's the highest the Gamecocks have debuted in the rankings since NET was introduced for the 2018-19 season. JSU's highest NET came on Jan. 21, 2019 at No. 114.

### GAMECOCKS DOMINATING THE GLASS

No team in the Ohio Valley Conference is better on the boards than Jacksonville State per game. JSU is averaging a team-best 39.69 rebounds per contest, ranking first in the OVC and 43rd in the NCAA. In total rebounds, JSU is fourth in the league with 516 this season.

### GAMECOCKS STAY DISCIPLINED

For the second season in a row, Jacksonville State is one of the lowest-fouling teams in the NCAA. This year, JSU is averaging 15.4 personal fouls per game - ranking second in the OVC and 34th in the nation. Last season, the Gamecocks finished third in the league and 57th in the NCAA with 15.8 fouls per game.

### 59-POINT WIN OVER CARVER COLLEGE

The Gamecocks routed Carver College 104-45 on Dec. 27 at Pete Mathews Coliseum. The 59-point victory was the fifth-largest margin of victory in the program's history and the third-largest since joining the Division I ranks.

### GAMECOCK OFFENSE SHINES VS. CARVER

Jax State's offense put up a number of season-high stats in its win over Carver College on Dec. 27 at Pete Mathews Coliseum. The Gamecocks scored 104 points, made 39 field goals, hit .574 percent of shots taken, hit 15 3-pointers, made .417 percent of 3-pointers taken and dished out 24 assists. The 104-point outing was the first time JSU reached the single-game century mark since Dec. 26, 2019 against Carver College at Pete Mathews Coliseum.

## Bill Jones COURT

The hardwood at Pete Mathews Coliseum was deemed Bill Jones Court on Feb. 22, 2018. Jones had a stellar career as a student-athlete and became JSU's first basketball All-American in 1966. He returned to Jacksonville State in 1974 to become the program's seventh head coach. In 24 seasons, Jones compiled a 449-210 record, making him the program's winningest coach. He is a member of both the JSU Athletic Hall of Fame and Alabama Sports Hall of Fame, but his highest honor remains leading the Gamecocks to the 1985 Division II National Championship.

### HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Jacksonville State is 473-170 at Pete Mathews Coliseum since its inaugural season in 1974-75. The home court advantage of the 3,500-seat arena has helped the Gamecocks to a 752-601 overall record since 1974.

### .736 WINNING PERCENTAGE AT HOME

The Gamecocks' 473-170 record inside Pete Mathews Coliseum averages out to a .736 winning percentage. JSU has won 10-or-more games in a single season on its home court on 26 occasions, including a 20-win season in 1994-95.



The Pete is home to the Alabama High School Athletic Association Boys' and Girls' Northeast Regional Tournament, and the Calhoun County Tournament has been hosted by Jacksonville State for over 30 years.

### THE PETE HOSTS FIRST DI SELLOUT

Pete Mathews Coliseum hosted its first sellout of the Division I era on Jan. 31, 2019. A total of 3,718 fans packed the 3,500-seat arena to watch the Gamecocks route NBA first-round pick Ja Morant and the Murray State Racers 88-68. Jacksonville State joined the Division I ranks in 1995-96.

### NEW VIDEO BOARDS

The Pete received three major video board upgrades during the offseason. A new Daktronics video board marquee now welcomes fans through the front doors into the building's main lobby, and two large video displays replaced lighted ad panels in the southwest and northeast corners of the playing arena.

### ADDED PRACTICE FACILITY

JSU added an auxiliary gym prior to the start of the 2019-20 season by renovating what was once an olympic-size swimming pool. The new full-size court, located on the east end of the coliseum, serves as an added practice surface for the volleyball and basketball programs when Bill Jones Court is otherwise occupied.

### IN THE RAFTERS

The 1985 Division II National Championship and 2017 Ohio Valley Conference Tournament Championship banners hang from the rafters. They are accompanied by retired jerseys for former men's basketball head coach and outstanding student-athlete Bill Jones, women's basketball standouts Jana and Dana Bright. A banner recognizing former JSU golfer and 2016 Master's champion Danny Willett also hangs from the rafters.

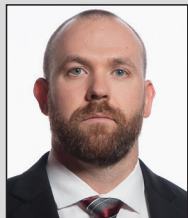

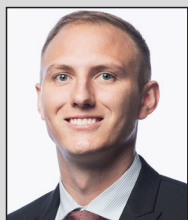
