### PLAYER TO WATCH

#15 Cameron Holden Junior Forward Forsyth, Ga.

The top scorer in the Ohio Valley Conference resides in Martin, Tennessee as Holden has tossed in a league-high 21.0 points per outing in league play this season. His 9.3 rebounds per game against league competition also ranks third.

Holden has topped UT Martin in scoring in five of the



last six games. That includes double-doubles at Southeast Missouri (career-high 24 points, 10 rebounds) and at Jacksonville State (23 points, career-best 11 rebounds).

### SETTING THE STAGE

The University of Tennessee at Martin will look to push its winning streak to three games in the all-time series against Tennessee State when the in-state foes square off for an Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball showdown.

The Skyhawks have won six of the last eight matchups against the Tigers dating back to the 2013-14 seasons. Both losses have come in the Gentry Center, including a slim 68-67 setback in UT Martin's last visit to Nashville on Jan. 31, 2019.

Cameron Holden has taken over the OVC's scoring lead in league play as the junior forward is supplying 21.0 points per outing. Sophomore guard Eden Holt paces the OVC with a .933 free throw percentage and a 3.0 assist-to-turnover ratio to help lead the Skyhawks in 2020-21. As a team, UT Martin tops the OVC with a 1.2 assist-to-turnover ratio (41 assists against 33 turnovers) when pitted against league competition.

The Skyhawks are coming off a 90-69 setback against OVC leader Belmont on Saturday. In that game, UT Martin knocked down 25 free throws - which is tied for the most against a Division I opponent since Feb. 20, 2014 (a span of 205 games). The Skyhawks placed four scorers in double figures (Holden, Holt, Jaron Williams, Ajani Kennedy) for the third time this season.

Tennessee State enters the contest on a string of bad luck as three of the Tigers' losses have been by four points or less. That includes an 83-79 double overtime setback on Saturday at Southeast Missouri and a 66-63 home loss to a nine-win Chattanooga squad on Dec. 22.

On Saturday, Tennessee State opened up its biggest lead of the night (nine points) with less than two minutes to go in regulation before facing an unrelenting comeback. The Tigers held Southeast Missouri to just 35.8 percent shooting for the game but were outscored by a 40-22 margin at the charity stripe.



### HOLDEN'S HISTORICAL FEAT

Cameron Holden became the first player in UT Martin history to pile up a double-double in his first two Ohio Valley Conference games. He tallied 24 points and 10 rebounds at Southeast Missouri on Dec. 18 before hauling in 23 points and 11 rebounds at Jacksonville State on Dec. 30.

### 3-0 FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 1989-90

UT Martin was 3-0 to start a season for the first time since the 1989-90 campaign, three years before it joined the NCAA Division I ranks.

The Skyhawks were one of the final 33 Division I teams to stay unbeaten before a Dec. 20 loss to Western Illinois.

### HOLT THE HERO IN OVC OPENER

Eden Holt dribbled coast-to-coast before knocking down a 15-foot pull-up jumper with 0.2 seconds left for the game-winning bucket at OVC rival Southeast Missouri.

BASKETBALL ACTIVITIES PAUSED
On Dec. 4, UT Martin's men's basketball activities were paused due to NCAA testing protocols.

As a result, four Skyhawk games were altered. UT Martin cancelled its Dec. 5 game at No. 5 Illinois and its Dec. 9 contest at No. 13 Tennessee. The Skyhawks postponed a matchup against Bethel (originally scheduled for Dec. 7, rescheduled for Dec. 15) and their original Ohio Valley Conference opener against Southeast Missouri (originally scheduled for Dec. 12, makeup date is Jan. 11).

### HOLDEN GETS TO THE STRIPE VS. BU

Cameron Holden pumped in a gamehigh 21 points in only 21 minutes off the bench against Bethel, including a 15-of-17 performance from the free throw line.

Holden's 15 makes were just two shy of the school record set by Mitch Stentiford against Southeast Missouri on Jan. 3, 1984 and were the most for any Skyhawk since Benzor Simmons converted 16 free throws at SIUE on Jan. 24, 2011.

**SKYHAWKS OUTLAST EVANSVILLE**The thrilling 93-87 triumph over Evansville in the Dec. 2 season opener marked the first double overtime game for the Skyhawks since Jan. 19, 2017, an 82-71 victory against Eastern Illinois.

### QUITE A DEBUT FOR HOLT

Sophomore Eden Holt pieced together a remarkable performance in his first game as a Skyhawk, pouring in a game-high 24 points in the 93-87 double overtime victory over Evansville. He was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for his efforts.

With UT Martin trailing by three points at the end of regulation, Holt drilled a

contested NBA-range three-pointer with one second left to force overtime. In the second overtime, Holt essentially iced the game with a 7-for-8 performance from the free throw line over the final 59 seconds.

Holt's 24 points marked the fourthhighest scoring game for a Skyhawk to make their debut during a season opener.

### <u>THOMAS JOINS RARE COMPANY</u>

By earning a start in the Dec. 2 triumph against Evansville, Anthony Thomas became the first UT Martin true freshman to start in a season opener since future All-Ohio Valley Conference honoree Javier Martinez accomplished that feat on Nov. 8, 2013 at Wyoming.

Thomas made more history on Dec. 22 as he tied a team-high with 7 points at Ole Miss. He became the first freshman to lead UT Martin in scoring since Parrish Hewitt (16 points) accomplished the feat at Eastern Illinois on Jan. 18, 2018 - a span of 76 games.

### <u>ROBINSON TABBED AS HEAD COA</u>CH

Montez Robinson was named interim head coach for the Skyhawk program on Nov. 17, two days after the sudden passing of Anthony Stewart.

Robinson brings five years of Division I head coaching experience to the Skyhawks, as he was the head coach at Alcorn State University in Lorman, Miss. from 2015-20.

At Alcorn State, Robinson compiled a 69-86 record - including a 50-40 mark in Southwestern Athletic Conference play (.556 winning percentage).

Robinson earned SWAC Coach of the

Year accolades in 2016-17 and was the NABC All-District 23 Co-Coach of the Year that same season. He was a two-time finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award and was also a finalist for the 2016 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award.

Prior to his stint at Alcorn State, Robinson was an assistant coach at Bethune-Cookman (2011-15), Kennesaw State (2005-11) and Truett-McConnell College (2002-05).

### SKYHAWKS FROM EVERYWHERE

The Skyhawk coaching staff searched far and wide to compile the 2020-21 roster, which includes four returners (including a redshirt transfer) and 12 newcomers.

UT Martin's 16-man roster includes student-athletes from 15 different states/ countries: Alabama, Arizona, Bosnia and Herzegovina, California, Finland, Georgia, Illinois, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, New Jersey, South Carolina, Texas and Virginia.

### <u>RETURNING DIVISION I EXPERIENCE</u>

UT Martin's four returners (Ajani Kennedy, Hannes Polla, Eric Rustin, Eman Sertovic) have combined for only three playing seasons in a Skyhawk uniform. However, Kennedy (one year at UC Riverside) and Polla (two years at Oklahoma) boast additional seasons of Division I experience outside of UT Martin.

Also, newcomer Kenton Eskridge played his freshman season at Southern Utáh, a Division I member of the Big Sky Conference.

### REMEMBERING ANTHONY STEWART

The college basketball world was stunned to hear of the passing of Skyhawk head coach Anthony Stewart on Nov. 15. He was just 50 years old and was set for his fifth season as head coach at UT Martin.

Stewart joined the Skyhawks in 2014 as the associate head coach under Heath Schroyer before being promoted as the program's 10th head coach.

Stewart guided the Skyhawks to 22 victories in his debut season (2016-17), equaling the school record for most wins in a single season. As a result, he was named a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award.

In memory of Coach Stewart, UT Martin will leave an empty suit jacket on the first seat of the bench at all games and will have a decal on the floor at home games this season.





# HERIM HEAD COACH MONTEZ ROB



Montez Robinson, who won Southwestern Athletic Conference Coach of the Year honors in 2016-17, was named the University of Tennessee at Martin's interim head coach on Nov. 17. He was originally hired as an assistant coach in September before being elevated to interim head coach two days after the sudden passing of Anthony Stewart.

Robinson comes to the Skyhawks as an assistant after a successful five-year stint as head coach at Alcorn State University. Taking over a program that was under NCAA sanctions for low Academic Progress Rate scores, the Fairfield, Ala. native improved the Braves program by nine victories in both overall and conference play in his debut season. Alcorn State finished second in the SWAC standings in 2015-16 after the team he inherited finished ninth during the previous season. Robinson additionally improved the program's academic standards as his recruiting classes averaged a 2.97 Grade Point Average during his tenure.

All in all, Robinson compiled a .556 winning percentage in league games with the Braves, including back-to-back second-place finishes (13-5 in 2015-16 and 2016-17). His first two seasons marked the first time that Alcorn State dialed up consecutive winning seasons in league play in 15 years. Last season, the Braves were predicted to finish ninth in the SWAC preseason standings but placed fourth with an 11-7 mark. Alcorn State received an invitation to play in the 2020


CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) and shattered the school record for single-season free throw percentage (.744) and three-point field goals made (268) in the process.

Robinson's best season occurred in 2016-17, when he guided the Braves to the SWAC Tournament championship game. He became the first Alcorn State representative to win SWAC Coach of the Year accolades since 2002 and was also crowned as the NABC All-District 23 Co-Coach of the Year. The Braves boasted an 11-game winning streak down the stretch, which was the fifth-longest streak in the nation and fourth-longest in school history. Robinson mentored HBCU All-Americans Marquis Vance and Reginal Johnson on their way to All-SWAC honors, marking the first time that Alcorn State garnered a pair of all-conference selections since 1998-99.

Robinson's impressive turnaround of the Braves program received national attention. He was a two-time finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coach of the Year Award (following the 2015-16 and 2016-17 seasons) and was also a finalist for the 2016 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award.

Before his first head coaching gig at Alcorn State, Robinson was an assistant coach at Bethune-Cookman University for four seasons (2011-15) under Gravelle Craig. During Robinson's time in Daytona Beach, Fla., Robinson helped the Wildcats advance to the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Tournament championship contest in 2012 and quarterfinal appearances on two other occasions. He worked closely with Bethune-Cookman's post players, including All-MEAC Tournament honoree Anthony Breeze.

Robinson was also a major factor in Kennesaw State University's transition from Division II to Division I. As an assistant for head coach Tony Ingle from 2005-11, Robinson aided the Owls in becoming one of the fastest-growing Division I men's basketball programs in the nation. Kennesaw State advanced to the Atlantic Sun Conference Tournament semifinals in their first season of



reclassification and won more games than any other NCAA reclassifying institution during a four-year period, eventually ranking in the top-5 in the mid-major polls. As the lead recruiting liaison, Robinson coached one conference Freshman of the Year, five all-conference players and seven players who went on to play professionally.

Robinson began his coaching career at Truett-McConnell College in Cleveland, Ga., where he was associate head coach and recruiting coordinator for three seasons (2002-05) under head coach Allen Sharpe. Robinson was part of yet another impressive turnaround with the Bears, as the program improved from an eight-win season to 24 victories (with just three scholarship studentathletes) during Robinson's first year. Robinson was part of a TMC squad who set the single-season school record for wins while mentoring eight All-Georgia Athletic Conference honorees and four players who played professionally following graduation.

A proud member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches, Robinson is married to the former Leah Hornbuckle. The couple has two children: a daughter, Tezlyn; and a son, Montez, Jr. After playing two seasons at Kemper Military Junior College in Boonville, Mo., Robinson finished out his playing career as co-captain of the men's basketball squad at North Georgia College and State University. He graduated in 2002 with a degree in criminal justice and later obtained his Master's degree in transformative leadership from Bethune-Cookman in 2014.

### UT MARTIN OUTLASTS EVANSVILLE IN EMOTIONAL 93-87 DOUBLE OVERTIME SEASON-OPENING WIN

UT Martin's season opener took 50 minutes to decide a victor as the Skyhawks made all the right plays down the stretch during a 93-87 double overtime triumph over Evansville at the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center.

UT Martin led for 43:47 of game time – opening up a lead as large as 14 points in the first half – before a late surge by the Purple Aces at the end of regulation. Eden Holt – who tossed in a gamehigh 24 points in his Skyhawk debut – knocked down a three-pointer from the right wing with one second remaining in the second half to force overtime.

In the two overtime periods, UT Martin shot 57.1 percent (4-of-7) while doing most of its damage at the charity stripe – sinking 15 of its 19 free throw attempts down the stretch.

Holt's 24 points came on 6-of-9 shooting (including 3-of-4 from beyond the three-point arc) and a 9-for-10 performance from the free throw line. Cameron Holden registered 16 points, a team-best eight rebounds and two blocks off the bench while Jaron Williams (11 points, five rebounds, three assists, three steals) and Eman Sertovic (10 points) also scored in double figures for the Skyhawks.

Evansville was led by Noah Frederking's 22 points while Jax Levitch compiled a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Shamar Givance and Thomasi Gilgeous-Alexander added 17 and 11 points, respectively.

Five UT Martin men's basketball players scored at least a dozen points as the Skyhawks ran away with a 95-60 triumph over the Bethel Wildcats at the Kathleen and Tom Elam Center.

Cameron Holden pumped in a game-high 21 points in only 21 minutes off the bench for UT Martin, including a 15-of-17 performance from the free throw line. His 15 makes were just two shy of the school record set by Mitch Stentiford against Southeast Missouri on Jan. 3, 1984 and were the most for any Skyhawk since Benzor Simmons converted 16 free throws at SIUE on Jan. 24, 2011.

Jaron Williams pitched in 19 points on 7-of-8 shooting and freshman Anthony Thomas scored all 17 of his points in the second half for UT Martin. Eden Holt tallied 14 points while Ajani Kennedy's 12 points and game-best 11 rebounds were good enough for the first double-double of his Skyhawk career.
